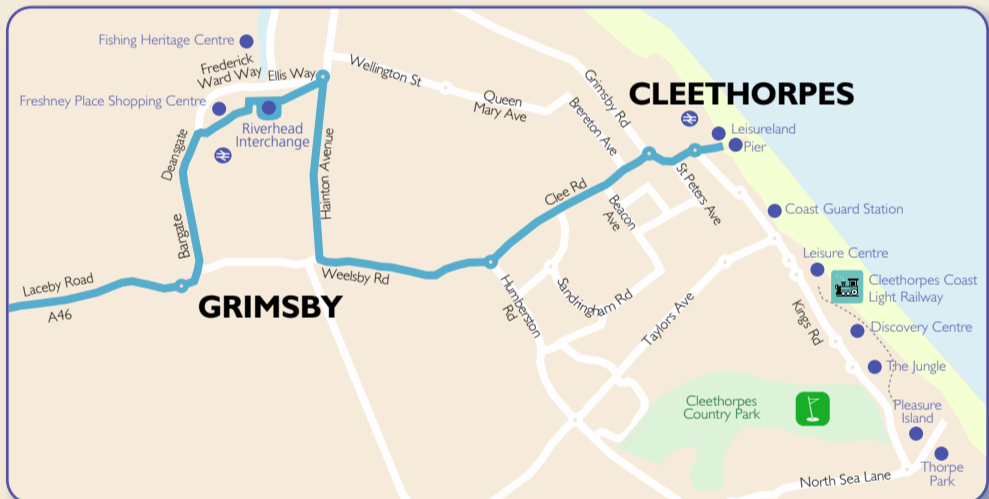

It boasts a varied and exciting shopping experience - the glass covered **Princes Quay** and the **St Stephen's Shopping Centre**. Here you will find a range of high street retailers and some specialist shops for that exclusive touch.
